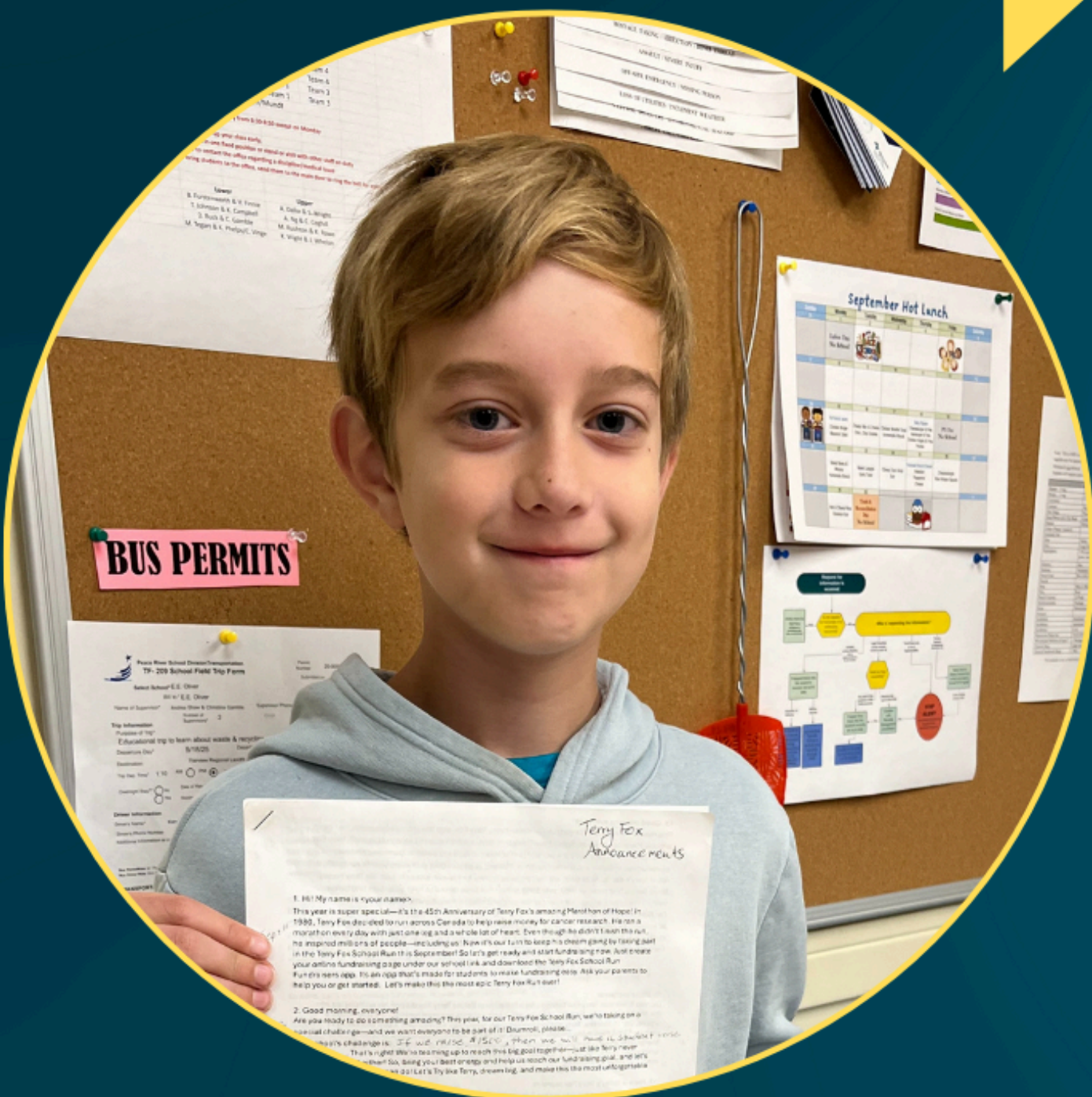




# Jack's

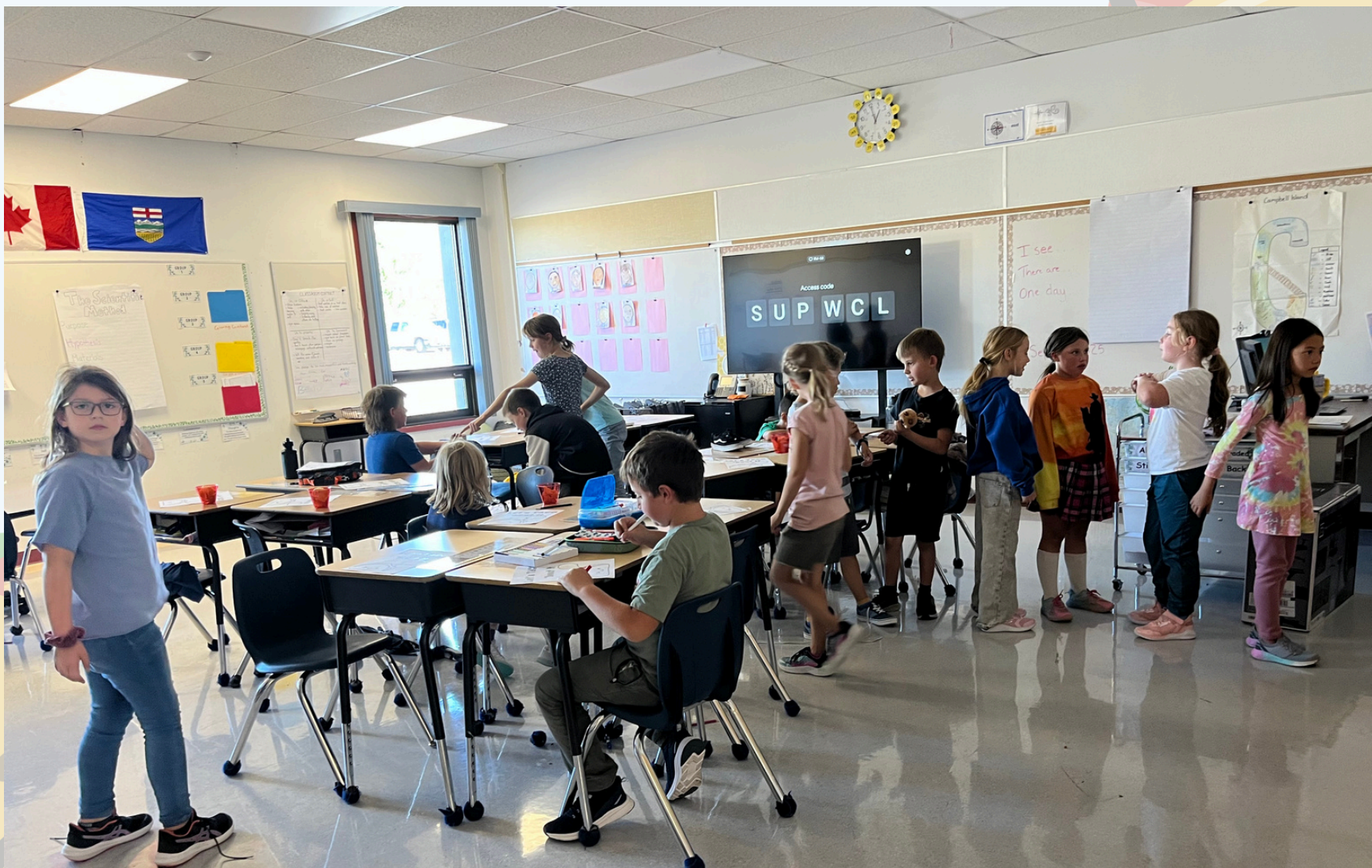
- My favourite Hockey team is the **Calgary Flames**

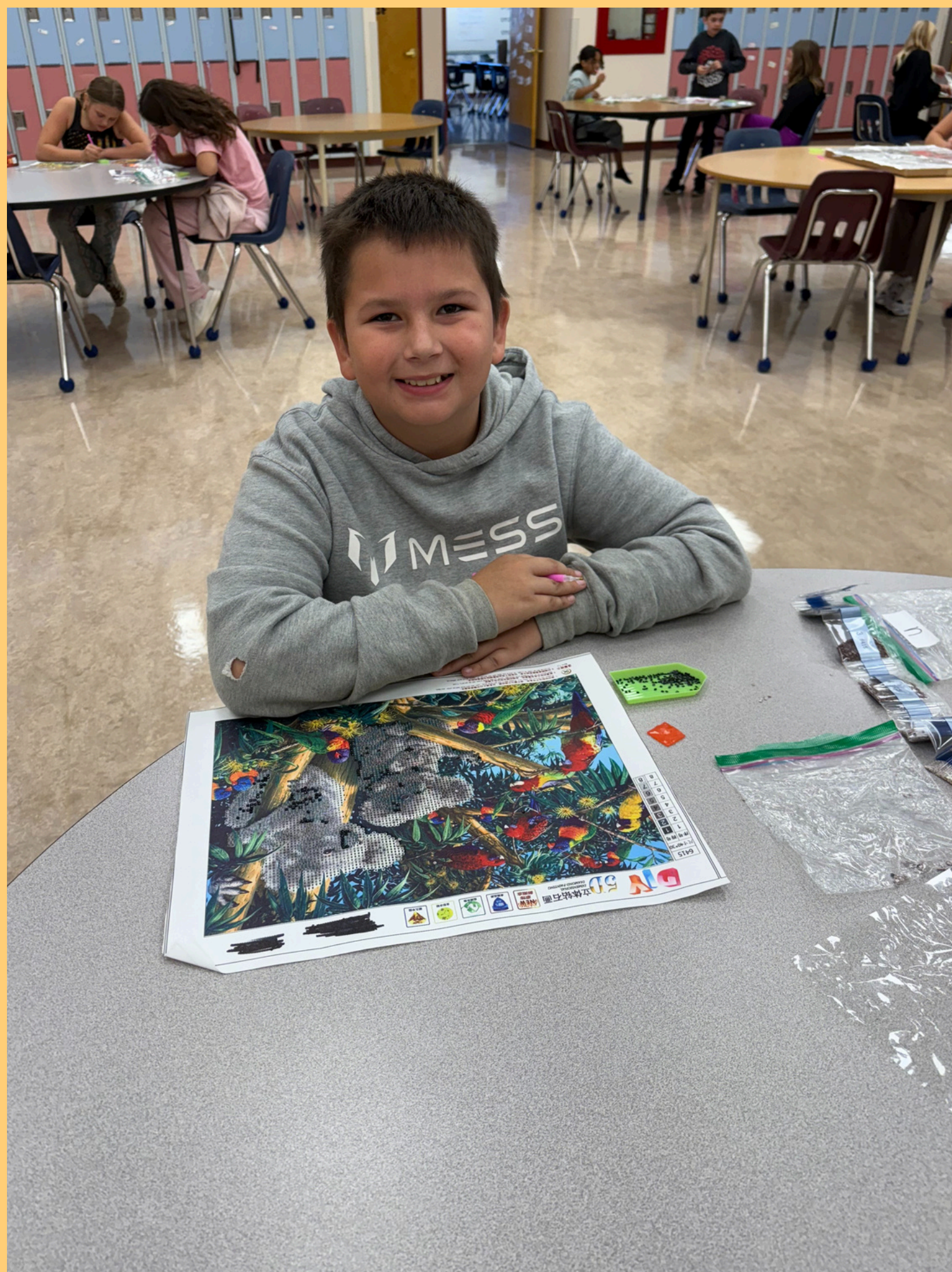

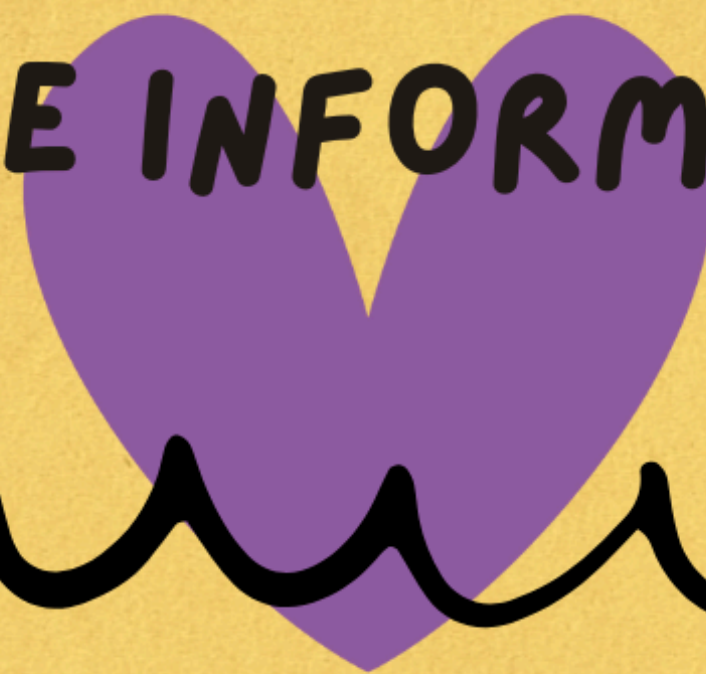
